\$1.6 MILLION TRANCHE 2 PLACEMENT COMPLETED

Arrow Minerals Limited (**Arrow** or the **Company**) is pleased to announce that it has completed the second tranche equity raising of \$1.6 million (*see announcement on 26 June 2019*). Along with the first tranche placement, Arrow has raised \$2.1 million (before costs) which will be used to fund exploration programmes at the Company's newly acquired Burkina Faso gold projects and the Strickland Gold Project in Western Australia. A total of 159.8 million shares were issued at 1¢ per Share together with a 1-for-2 attaching option exercisable at 2¢ pursuant to listing rule 7.3.
