## SCA confirms eligibility for JobKeeper extension

Southern Cross Media Group Limited (ASX: SXL) (**SCA**) announces it is eligible for continued support under the extended JobKeeper program from 28 September 2020 to 3 January 2020. The eligibility test requiring revenues to be more than 30% below the prior comparative period was met in the September quarter.

SCA expects to receive approximately \$12 million in JobKeeper support payments to offset employee costs from 28 September 2020 to 3 January 2020.

Advertising bookings for the December quarter are stronger and the gradual easing of COVID-19 restrictions in Victoria will further aid recovery of revenues. Accordingly, SCA expects it will not be eligible for JobKeeper support beyond 3 January 2021.

SCA's balance sheet has continued to strengthen. On 30 September 2020, net debt was \$93 million, a reduction of \$39 million since 30 June 2020. Management forecasts this further reduction in net debt, together with an improving trading outlook and the above anticipated JobKeeper receipts, will result in leverage on 31 December 2020 being below 1.0x Net Debt / EBITDA<sup>1</sup> – providing significant headroom against the group's 4.5x leverage covenant.

A further trading update will be provided at the AGM on 30 October 2020.
