During the quarter ended 30 September 2020 Stream Group Ltd ("Stream") continued to provide insurance claims management software to claims management companies and to progress the upgrading of BuildAssist, the Company's core software product. Revenues remained subdued due to the low volume of insurance claims in New Zealand, our principal market.
