GetSwift Limited (ASX:GSW) – request for suspension of quotation

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.2, GetSwift Limited (ACN 604 611 556) (**Getswift**) requests the suspension of Getswift securities from official quotation, effective from the close of trading today (being Monday, 4 January 2021).

This follows lodgement with the Australian Securities and Investments Commission (**ASIC**) of orders of the Federal Court of Australia (**Orders**) approving the scheme of arrangement (**Scheme**) pursuant to which GetSwift Technologies Limited (**Holdco**) will acquire all of the shares in GetSwift to effect the re-domiciliation of GetSwift.

GetSwift provides the following information in accordance with Listing Rule 17.2:

1. GetSwift has requested the suspension of GetSwift securities from official quotation following lodgement with ASIC of the Orders approving the Scheme, in order to facilitate implementation of the Scheme.
2. GetSwift requests the suspension of its securities from official quotation until GetSwift requests to be removed from the official list of the ASX, which is anticipated to occur on 15 January 2021 following implementation of the Scheme. Please do not remove GetSwift from the official list prior to receipt of its requests to do so.
3. The request for removal from the official list is expected to be made following implementation of the Scheme, which is expected to occur on 13 January 2021. That request will specify a date for delisting to take effect.
4. GetSwift is not aware of any reason why its securities should not be suspended.
5. GetSwift is not aware of any other information necessary to inform the market about the suspension.
