COMMITMENT TO SMOKE-FREE INDOOR ENVIRONMENTS

MELBOURNE: Crown Resorts Limited (ASX: CWN) (Crown) announced today that it will phase out indoor smoking at its Australian resorts by the end of December 2022.

Smoking exemptions currently permit indoor smoking in certain premium gaming areas with appropriate air filtration technology.

The move to a smoke-free indoor gaming environment will commence immediately in some of Crown's premium gaming areas, with a transition period for other areas until the end of December 2022 to enable the progressive installation of appropriate outdoor smoking areas for patrons.

Crown's Executive Chairman, Helen Coonan, said:

"We are committed to responding to community sentiment and expectations regarding smoking. Crown's decision to phase out indoor smoking at its properties has been made in response to those shifting expectations. The health and safety of our employees, guests and the community are our priority."
