MLC FY21 half year financial results

IOOF Holdings Ltd (IOOF) notes today's market announcement from National Australia Bank Ltd (NAB) regarding NAB's FY21 half year financial results.

Included in these results is an overview of the performance of MLC for the half-year to 31 March 2021. MLC is categorised by NAB as a discontinued operation following the announcement on 31 August 2020 that IOOF will acquire MLC, subject to regulatory approvals.

Cash earnings for MLC can be found in a footnote on page 74 of the NAB Appendix 4D released to the ASX earlier this morning.

IOOF notes that for the half-year to 31 March 2021, MLC's "cash earnings" were \$56 million. However, IOOF notes that classifications of items under NAB Group reporting differ from how IOOF will report the performance of MLC post completion.
