The FBICRC has a portfolio of 17 research and development projects which span the battery value chain and bring together 70 industry participants, including major corporations such as BASF, BHP and IGO, the federal government, four state governments (WA, QLD, SA and NT) and eight research partners with a combined value in excess of \$120 million over six years.

Headquartered in Perth, the FBICRC has an ambitious six-year, research and development program targeting all segments of the battery value chain: the policy and governance framework for battery industries; the processes for extraction, refining and processing of raw materials and advanced battery component materials, and their recycling; and the testing, manufacture and deployment of battery components and systems.
