Request for Trading Halt

Pursuant to Listing Rule 17.1, Japara Healthcare Limited (ASX:JHC) ("Japara") requests an immediate trading halt be granted by ASX with respect to Japara's ordinary shares.

For the purposes of Listing Rule 17.1, Japara provides the following information:

- (a) Japara is seeking a trading halt pending an announcement about the outcome of a shareholders meeting to consider a scheme of arrangement due to be held at 10am (Melbourne time) on 21 October 2021, which, if passed, may effect a change of control of Japara;
- (b) Japara wishes the trading halt to remain in place until the earlier of such time as it makes an announcement to the market in relation to outcome of the meeting and the commencement of trading on 25 October 2021; and
- (c) Japara is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted or of any other information necessary at this stage to inform the market about the trading halt
