2021 Annual Shareholder Meeting: Results of Meeting

The Annual Shareholder Meeting (**ASM**) of Genesis Energy Limited (**GNE**) was held virtually on Friday, 29 October 2021. Shareholders were asked to vote on three resolutions, which were supported by the Board.

The resolutions passed by shareholders were:

- That Barbara Chapman be re-elected as a Director of the Company;
- That James Moulder be re-elected as a Director of the Company; and
- That the annual total pool for Directors' remuneration be increased by \$132,950, from \$940,000 to \$1,072,950, with the increase taking effect from 1 November 2021.

Details of the votes cast are as follows:
