Overview of JobKeeper Payments Received During COVID-19 Pandemic

Flight Centre Travel Group (ASX: FLT) today released details of the wage subsidies it received under the Federal Government's JobKeeper program, in accordance with recent amendments to the Corporations Act.

As outlined in the accompanying document, FLT was eligible for \$96.4million in JobKeeper payments during the 2020 fiscal year (FY20) and an additional \$152million during FY21, based on its Australian workforce of circa 9400 people.

The total payments during FY20 and FY21 consisted of:

- \$120million, which was passed through directly to stood-down employees; and
- \$128million, which subsidised the wages paid to continuing employees

FLT was deeply impacted by COVID-19 and the border closures that were implemented to slow its spread.

After delivering a \$343.1million underlying profit before tax during FY19 (pre-COVID), the company reported underlying losses before tax of \$509.2million and \$507.1million during FY20 and FY21 respectively.
