JOBKEEPER PAYMENTS DISCLOSURE

In accordance with subsection 323DB(1) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth), Myer Holdings Limited (ASX:MYR) today discloses the JobKeeper payments received, as attached to this release.

Of the total JobKeeper payments of \$144 million received during FY20 and FY21:

- \$60 million was paid directly to eligible team members whose remuneration was below the required income threshold under the JobKeeper Payment Scheme; and
- the balance of \$84 million was used to subsidise wages paid to continuing team members.

The JobKeeper wage subsidy was critical in maintaining connection to the workforce and ensured a significant number of roles could be maintained during the eligibility period.

The Company only qualified for the first phase of the JobKeeper Payment Scheme which ended on 27 September 2020.
