Incident at Curragh mine complex

Coronado Global Resources Inc ("Coronado", the "Company" ASX: CRN) advises that a fatality involving one of its employees has occurred at its Curragh operations in Queensland, Australia this morning.

Coronado is deeply saddened by this morning's tragic event and are working with all appropriate authorities to secure the site and understand the cause of the incident. Coronado extends its deepest sympathies and sincere condolences to the family, friends and colleagues of the individual.

A full investigation is being conducted into the accident and Coronado is working with the Queensland Police, the Department of Natural Resources, Mines and Energy and other authorities.

Operations at Curragh have been temporarily suspended to allow authorities to work through the necessary investigation activities. The Company is focused on supporting the family of the employee and workers at Curragh and counselling services are being made available.

Coronado will provide further updates as they become available.
