## Stockland announces estimated distribution for six months to 30 June 2023

Stockland (ASX:SGP) today announced an estimated distribution for the six months to 30 June 2023 of 14.4 cents per Ordinary Stapled Security. This equates to a full year distribution payment of 26.2 cents per Ordinary Stapled Security, in line with guidance previously issued by Stockland.

The Record Date for determining entitlement to the half year distribution is Friday 30 June 2023. The distribution payment will be made on Thursday 31 August 2023.

The announcement of Stockland's full year financial results and lodgement of Appendix 4E will be made on Thursday 24 August 2023. This announcement will include details of the actual distribution for the six months to 30 June 2023.
