- Rex exited Adelaide to Whyalla route following Whyalla City Council's decision to impose security screening charges on Rex's services that are not legally required to be screened.
- NJE launched a Brisbane base and commenced air services for BHP Mitsubishi Alliance (BMA) on 3 July 2023.
- → Rex submitted a response to the Request for Information (RFI) issued by the Australian Antarctic Division (AAD) in a bid to be the next aerial operator of the Australian Antarctic Program.
- The NJE Logistics Enterprise Agreement was voted in unanimously.









- → Pel-Air signed an extension agreement on the Iluka Resources contract on 20 July 2023.
- → Rex took delivery of its 8th Boeing 737-800NG aircraft on 28 July 2023.
- → Rex commenced its new Melbourne Hobart domestic service on 17 August 2023. This marks the 9th route on its domestic jet network.
- → AAPA resumed intake of new cadet pilots (60) from China for the first time since COVID.











- Rex took delivery of its 9th Boeing 737-800NG aircraft on 25 September 2023.
- → Rex announces temporary reductions to its regional network commencing 30th October 2023 due to relentless pillaging of pilots by major domestic carriers.
- → Rex Group bagged three awards at the Australian Aviation Awards for 2023:
 - Airline of the year (REX)
 - Safety Innovator of the year (REX)
 - Flight training business of the year (AAPA)

- → Rex unveils 'Rex Flyer' on 2 October 2023, a new loyalty program for its frequent flyers.
- → Rex was re-awarded the contract for the WA regulated routes of Esperance, Albany and Carnarvon/Monkey Mia for a period of 5 years from 2 October 2023.
- → NJE took delivery of it's 9th De Havilland Dash 8-400 aircraft on 18 October 2023.
- → Rex commenced its new Adelaide Brisbane domestic service on 30 October 2023. This marks the 10th route on its domestic jet network.









- → Rex submitted a response to the Request for Expression of Interest (REOI) issued by the Department of Home Affairs for the Provision of Aerial Surveillance Services for the Australian Border Force.
- → Rex commenced Brisbane-Cairns RPT route on 22 November 2023 drawing on NJE resources.
- NJE pilot EBA was voted up on 20 November 2023.
- Rex was awarded the APEX award for best Cabin Service in South Pacific.









→ Rex took delivery of it's 10th Boeing 737-800NG aircraft on 13 December 2023.

→ Rex customer service staff EBA voted up on 8 December 2023.

→ NJE secured another new contract in December, marking its seventh new contract since the start of the FY. Revenue in 1HFY24 grew 15.7% above prior period.







Subsequent Events

- → Agreement signed for the sale of 3 KingAir B200C aircraft which are due to retire from the Ambulance Victoria fixed wing air ambulance contract in Q4FY24.
- → Rex extends reductions to regional network until 27 October 2024.
- → Pel-Air commenced partial Pilatus PC24 introduction into NSW Ambulance Services.
- NJE commenced Brisbane to Gladstone services. This marks its seventh charter. destination in Queensland since establishing its Queensland base in July 2023.

Outlook

Group full-year revenue expected to increase due to:

- Additional flying of up to 3 additional B737-800NGs to the fleet.
- Rex Flyer (Frequent Flyer Programme) launched in Q2 FY2024
- Increase of foreign cadets at AAPA with worldwide surge in demand for pilot training
- From early 4QFY24, full commencement of the new Ambulance Victoria contract as well as full induction of 2 Pilatus PC24 jets into the NSW Ambulance contract
- > Strong growth of new charter contracts for NJE. Full FY revenue expected to be at least 17% above prior period.
