Trading – Cash Markets (including equities, interest rate and warrant trades)

- In April 2024, the average daily number of trades was up 16% on the pc. The average daily value traded on-market of \$5.231 billion was up 1% on the pc.
- Volatility (as measured by the average daily movement in the All Ordinaries Index) was 0.6% in April, compared to 0.3% in the pc.
- Future volatility (as measured by the S&P/ASX 200 VIX) in April was an average of 11.7, down 10% on pc.
