Appointment of Interim Chief Financial Officer

21 April 2026 - Global analytical science and device company Trajan Group Holdings Limited (ASX: TRJ) (Trajan or the Company) has today announced the appointment of Mr Simon Billingham as Interim Chief Financial Officer and Interim Joint Company Secretary. Simon replaces outgoing Chief Financial Officer, Mr Alister Hodges, whose resignation was announced on 25 March 2026.
